



Gate Safe Aware Installer/Supporter Joining Instructions

Thank you for registering for the Gate Safe Aware training course.

The half day course will cover:

- Scope and nature of legislation and standards relevant to automated gate safety
- Implications of failure to install equipment to the required standard
- Risk assessment protocol
- Styles and configurations of different gates and associated risks
- Details of recommended safety features and correct installation guidance
- Additional safety considerations
- Importance of maintenance
- Practical examples of good and bad practice

A 10 Part multiple choice test is taken at the end of the course to gain accreditation to the Gate Safe Aware scheme, if you or any of your colleagues require additional time due to learning difficulties such as dyslexia then please make us aware prior to arrival.

Delegates will receive an IOSH accredited certificate and a comprehensive training manual upon successful completion of the training. Stationery will be provided to all delegates.

Those attendees who pass the training also receive access to the Gate Safe Aware Installer / Gate Safe Supporter logos for a 12 month period – full guidance on the correct usage of the logo will be supplied. Each delegate will also receive a Gate Safe ID Card (a photograph will be taken on the day of the course which will then feature on the ID card).

The IOSH certificate is provided by IOSH and can take up to 6-8 weeks from the date of the course to be processed.

Gate Safe will update the Gate Safe website which references the installer/supporter database with the details of every delegate that passes the course (taken from the registration form), providing that full payment has been received.

Gate Safe also provides delegates with access to other materials such as a Gate Safe Aware sales leaflet to help raise awareness of the Gate Safe programme and its aims. This can be branded to promote a company's membership to the Gate Safe Aware scheme, whilst at the same time educating customers to appreciate the importance of a Gate Safe installation.

The logo and sales leaflet etc will be sent out to you within 3-5 working days of the date of the course.

Tea, coffee and biscuits are provided on arrival and at the break, lunch is not provided.
